-. Introduction.

Chile International Cup UCI class 2 is an Olympic Cross Country date and is inserted in both the international UCI calendar and the Calendar of the Cycling Federation of Chile.

ANGOL is a provincial capital of the Araucania region. It is located in the center of the region and at the foot of the Nahuelbuta Mountain Range. Close to this city, there are several of the great cities of southern Chile: Concepcion (150 km), Temuco (160 km) and Los Angeles (60 km) and 540 km from the capital.

Because of its mountainous geographic characteristics and temperate rainy climate, Angol is an ideal place to practice MountainBike. It is surrounded by green mountains covered with vegetation, among conifers and native forest, which gives it a special charm. The place where the circuit is located is a large property owned by Forestal Mininco, 10 minutes from the city center, in the direction of the Nahuelbuta National Park. In this precint, is planned the largest Bike Park in the area, sponsored by Forestal Mininco.

It will be governed by the UCI regulations for the discipline of MountainBike, published on the page www.uci.ch.

-. Start Order

It will be established according to the latest UCI ranking published on the date of the event

-. Competition clothing

The National Champions must present themselves with the clothing that identifies them as such

-. Control System

The times of the athletes will be controlled by timekeeping done by national commissioners under a manual system

-. Award

1st Place Gold Medal

2nd Place Silver Medal

3rd Place Bronze Medal

The medalist athletes have the obligation to present themselves with their official cyclist clothing. The national champions must present themselves with their corresponding clothing in competition

-. Scoring and Awards UCI

Chile International Cup XCO Class 2, registered in the International Cycling Union, will award points for the UCI World Ranking, the score will be assigned in the Elite/U23 general, both ladies and men. For the monetary award, the financial obligations published by the UCI for Class 2 races in the Federation 2 group will be respected, according to the attached list, and will be delivered in a sealed envelope on the day of the competition in the award ceremony.

The MountainBike Sports Club requests the National Anti-Doping Commission, belonging to the National Sports Institute, its presence in the event for the respective controls under the UCI Standard, being possible to apply in all categories.

-. National Ranking

The Cycling Federation of Chile, will carry a general ranking of all categories in Chile International Cup in the XCO modality, at the end of the 5 dates the winners of each category will be awarded. Athletes who have federated before the end of the 5 dates will be eligible for this Ranking.


